What to do if you have a complaint

The Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board is committed to working cooperatively and responsibly with parents as we nurture the development of students. We welcome the opportunity to support open and respectful communication with all families.

BELIEFS

The Huron-Perth Catholic District School Board believes that conflict resolution is most successfully achieved when mutually acceptable solutions are designed in the best interests of the students, school and the school district as a whole.

RESOLUTIONS

On the basis of the principle of "first contact" – parents must address concerns directly to teachers before raising these concerns with the school or board administration.

Likewise, if a parent has a concern about the school administration, the parent is expected to deal with that concern with the school administration first, before raising these concerns with the Superintendent of Education.

If, in the view of the complainant, the ruling of the school principal is unacceptable, the complainant may address his/her concern(s) to the Superintendent of Education in writing. The letter must outline the nature of the original complaint, the steps that have been taken, and in what way the decision of the school principal is unacceptable. Upon receipt of such a letter, the Superintendent will direct the correspondence to the appropriate department for resolution.
