Treasurer Report

- Current balance is \$12,216.36 (total of \$1031.21 for the school fair is not out of this account yet, to be transferred to Grade 8 graduation or Grade 7/8 trip)
- · Greyhaven total has not come out of this account yet

Principal's Report

· a. EQAO results and next steps

- EQAO: Percentage of students who scored level 3 or above:
 - Grade 3: 52% (reading), 44% (writing), 39% (math)
 - Grade 6: 55% (reading), 55% (writing), 30% (math)
- Started to train staff and implementing a reading screener, then grouping at risk students and implementing correcting reading (a tier 2 intervention)
- EMPOWER more targeted, intense intervention
- "Do the math" a new program for grades 6,7,8
- Math coach at the board office to identify students who need help and to help teachers create interventions to move students forward
- Hopeful to see results pay off at next years EQAO results and EQAO results over time
- Exploring other avenues to help make a conducive learning environment (mental health, breakfast club etc.)

• b. Christmas French Cafe

- December 7, 2023 with grades 4-8 involved
- Matinee and 2 evening shows

· c. Primary Christmas Concert/Liturgical Celebration

- December 20th primary Christmas concert to be hosted at the Church
- Faith based, each class will have a role to play (dramatic/musical piece)
- JK/SK, SK/1 will be doing a Christmas art show on December 15th

· d. Parent Inquiry: Classroom attendance at monthly masses

- Goal is to have the kindergarten classes attending mass eventually (by Spring)
- · Working at reinforcing and building routine
- e. Experience St. Anne's Night

- Wednesday November 22nd, information was sent out in 'The BEAT'
- Targeted towards Grade 8 students, but Grade 6-8 can attend
- Starts at 6pm with a scavenger hunt with different workshops throughout the evening

CPIC Meeting

- Christa attended meeting in Dublin, bylaws reviewed
- New strategic plan to be chosen, reached out to community for suggestions
- Discussed new \$500 for CSAC that can be used in conjunction with PRO grant
- February 20th is the next CPIC meeting

Fundraising

- Discussed approaching the Knights of Columbus to host an event and then donate the funds back to CSAC - Nicole to reach out to Deacon Wayne regarding the Knights of Columbus hosting Spring fundraiser
- Discussed having a silent auction/trivia night with a lasagna meal we get 1 free use of the Knights of Columbus hall, could use it for this
- · Going to use the PRO grant at the spring BBQ

PRO Grant

- PRO grant amount is \$552 plus an additional \$500 (\$1012 to spend)
- Lucknow school did a literacy night, parent engagement is required (they gave an at home learning package)
- Run in conjunction with the Spring BBQ so we are not having 2 separate nights
- Can ask the literacy coach from the board office to attend and do a demonstration
- Mike to bring PRO grant form to next meeting and CSAC will fill complete and submit
